## Construction Update

Beginning summer 2021, contractors for the City of Fort Myers will start Phase I construction of the First Street and Second Street Two-Way Traffic Conversion Project. Phase I will convert First, Second and Seaboard streets from one-way to two-way traffic to produce positive safety benefits quickly & efficiently. Work is expected to occur Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.; however, some night and weekend work may be necessary. This project is expected to be completed in summer 2022.

- Contractors are setting up the staging area at the southwest corner of Michigan Avenue and Seaboard Street intersection and installing erosion control devices throughout the project area.

### Palm Beach Boulevard and Seaboard Street Intersection

- Surveyors will be installing construction limit stakes in the vicinity of the Palm Beach Boulevard and Seaboard Street intersection.
  - Motorists should expect Palm Beach Boulevard east and west bound lanes to be intermittently reduced to one-lane in each direction during the staking of the medians.
