Construction Update

Beginning summer 2021, contractors for the City of Fort Myers will start Phase I construction of the First Street and Second Street Two-Way Traffic Conversion Project. Phase I will convert First, Second and Seaboard streets from one-way to two-way traffic to produce positive safety benefits quickly & efficiently. Work is expected to occur Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.; however, some night and weekend work may be necessary. This project is expected to be completed in summer 2022.

Palm Beach Boulevard/First Street

Motorists should expect the inside westbound lane closed from Seaboard Street to E. Riverside Drive through the end of September.

Seaboard Street

Motorists will be unable to travel northbound onto E. Riverside Drive from Seaboard Street. To access E. Riverside Drive motorists should continue westbound on First Street and turn right on Oasis Way and then right on Frierson Street. This detour will remain in place through the end of September.
